

Stephen C. Foster State Park Day Use Waterway Map

1. Stephen Foster State Park Office and Boat Basin
2. Boat Canal (no wake zone) .3 miles long
3. Five Sisters - Five cypress trees located in a small cove
4. Bee Tree - Large hollow stump with two branches
5. Gator Cove
6. The Hollow Tree

Rules and Regulations

Fishing - Valid Georgia fishing license required. All state regulations apply. No live minnows may be used as bait.

Canoeing and Motor Boating - Motors limited to 10 hp or less. Each boat occupant to have a coast guard approved life preserver.

Swimming - Prohibited in refuge waters.

Firearms and Other Weapons - Prohibited on the refuge except during designated hunts.

Pets - Pets are not permitted in public buildings or boats.

Disturbing or Collecting Plants or Animals - Strictly prohibited. **Do Not Feed or Harass the Wildlife in any way.**

Refuge Travel - Restricted to Day Use waterways without an overnight permit.

Wildlife Refuge Gate Hours

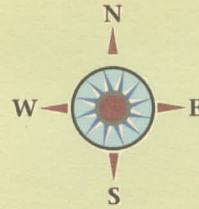
September 15 thru February 28

6:30 a.m. - 8:30 p.m.

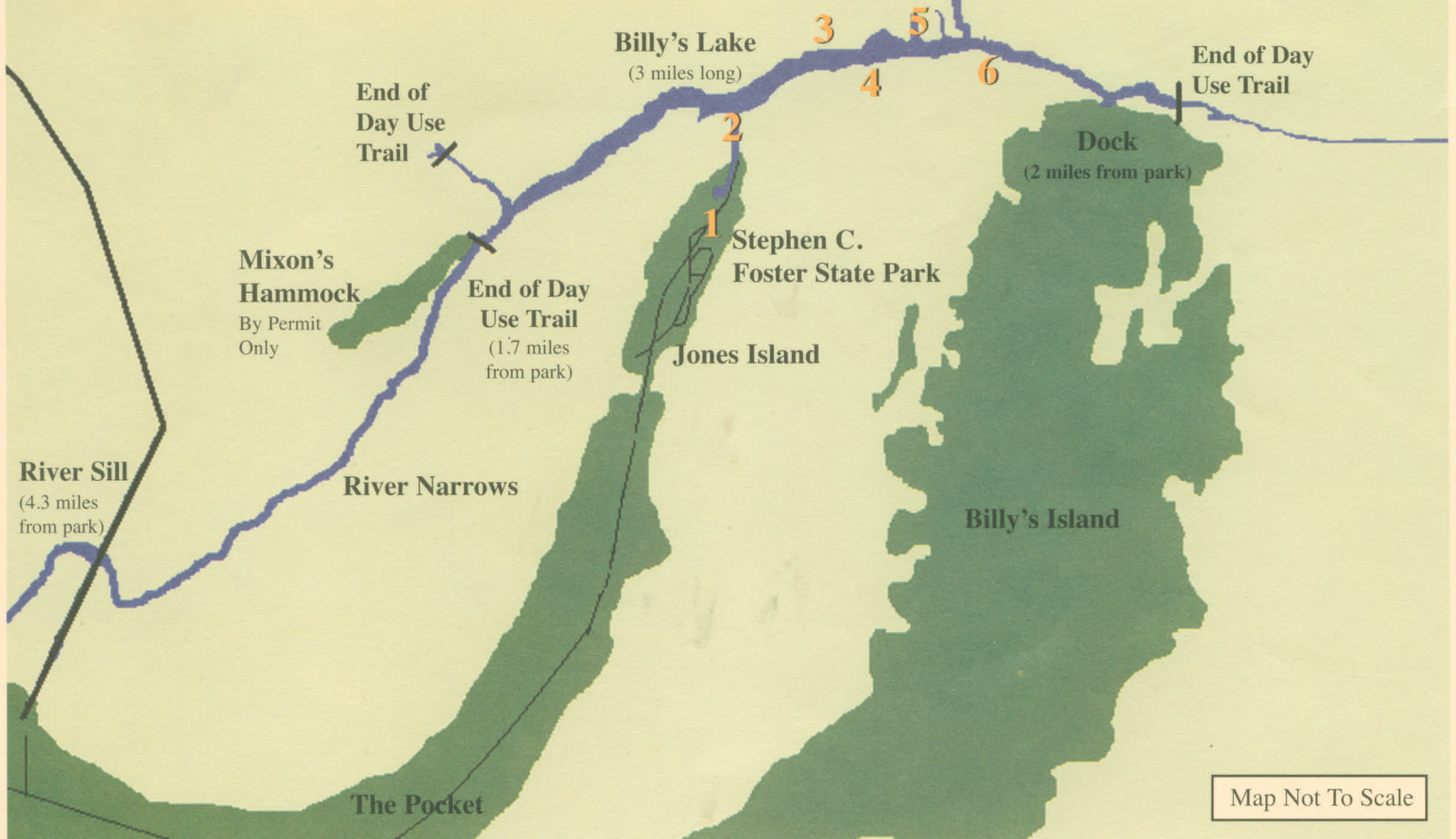
